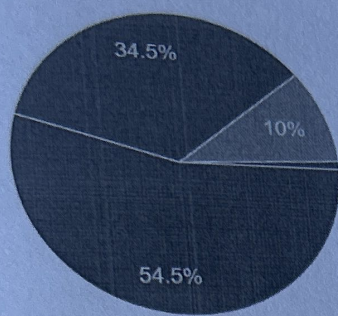
1. Spreaded happiness and warmth at the college premises with this celebration.

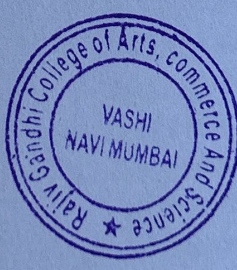
