Details of Activity:

Rajiv Gandhi College of Arts, Commerce and Science (NSS unit) has organized 'Blood Donation Camp' on 4th September 2019, on the occasion of 'Founder's Day'. The camp was organized in collaboration with Navi Mumbai "Pallavi Blood Bank", Kharghar. The camp was arranged at an auditorium on the 4th floor in college premises.

The function started around 8:00 AM. The camp was inaugurated by our founder Shree Haribans singh ji. Our students with their parents had participated in the blood donation camp. Along with teaching and non- teaching staff, Alumni also actively participated in this camp. The blood collected from this camp was to be around **60 units**. The College had arranged refreshments for those who donated blood in the camp. The participants who donated blood were given certificates and gifts.

To oversee the entire process and to collect the blood, a team of doctors and nurses were put incharge. Before donating the blood the team were checking BP and Hemoglobin. The college had also arranged for a resting room for anyone who felt dizzy or sick after donating blood and volunteers were present over there to take care of them.

The camp was ended with the blood donation by our college principal Mrs. B.S. Pandey. After the donation, sir had given a vote of thanks to everyone and the camp successfully ended with the National Anthem.



Outcomes:

- 1) Blood pressure was checked and Hemoglobin level was confirmed.
- 2) The donor students are given a certificate of appreciation.
- 3) The sick students will get proper medical advice from the Doctors..
