**Descriptive Report :-**

Sainath Education Trust's Rajiv Gandhi College of Arts, Commerce and Science has organized 'Cleanliness Drive' on 10<sup>th</sup> August 2019. The main purpose of this program was to create awareness among the students regarding cleanliness & its benefits. Under this program, all the students of Rajiv Gandhi college had to participate. Even Asst. professor Mrs. Anamika Singh and Asst. Prof. Arun Vishwakarma were the essential part of this Drive. As a part of this cleanliness drive, we had to clean the whole college. Principal Mr. B.S. Pandey was honored for his exceptional leadership and support to the NSS Unit.

The 'Cleanliness Drive' started at 11.00 am with a Motivational speech by Asst. Prof. Anamika Singh in the morning. Principal Mr. B.S. Pandey started the program by cleaning the corners of the playground. Then professors and students followed suit. Some of the volunteers picked brooms and started our job.
