Activity: Free Eye Checkup Camp

Date & Time: 5th February 2020 10.30 am to 1.30 pm.

Details of Activity:

Sainath Education Trust's Rajiv Gandhi College of Arts, Commerce and Science NSS UNIT in association with local healthcare partners and volunteers, organized an Free Eye Checkup Camp at Auditorium (4th floor) on 5th February 2020 from 10.30 am to 1.30 pm .Programme starts with felicitation of doctors by our programme Officer Kamal Jain .The camp aimed to promote eye health awareness and provide accessible eye care services to the college community and the local population.

A team of Eye specialists came to do eye checkup of the Students ,Teaching and non Teaching Staffs. the camp was advantageous for all of us as we got an opportunity to know more about various aspects of eye care. The doctors brought well-equipped eye examination tools to examine the students, teaching and non-teaching effectively. They also spoke to the students about how to increase awareness and improve access to eye healthcare services.

Camp Objectives:

Promote Eye Health Awareness: Raise awareness about the importance of regular eye checkups and maintaining good eye health.Screen for Vision Problems: Identify and address common vision problems among participants.Detecting Eye Conditions: Early detection and referral for



eye conditions and diseases. Educate and Inform: Offer educational sessions on proper eye care and preventive measures.

Camp Activities:

Upon arrival, participants were warmly welcomed by our dedicated team of volunteers who managed the registration process efficiently. The camp featured the following activities:

Vision Screening: Trained optometrists conducted comprehensive vision screenings, including visual acuity tests, refraction tests, and eye pressure checks.

Eye Examinations: Ophthalmologists provided detailed eye examinations, including fundus examinations and slit lamp evaluations.

Outcome: -

1. Vision Problems Identified
2. Many participants expressed their appreciation for the camp's organization, the professionalism of the medical team, and the dedication of volunteers.
3. Several participants requested that the college organize more frequent eye checkup camps to continue addressing the eye health needs of the community.
4. Educational sessions reached 41 individuals, equipping them with essential knowledge on eye care, prevention of eye injuries, and maintenance of good eye hygiene.



Eye Check camp:
