

On December 1, 2020, Rajiv Gandhi College in Vashi organized a guest lecture to commemorate World AIDS Day. The event aimed to raise awareness about HIV/AIDS, dispel myths, and promote a better understanding of the disease.

The guest lecture featured V.Ravishankar, an expert in the field of HIV/AIDS research and advocacy.
