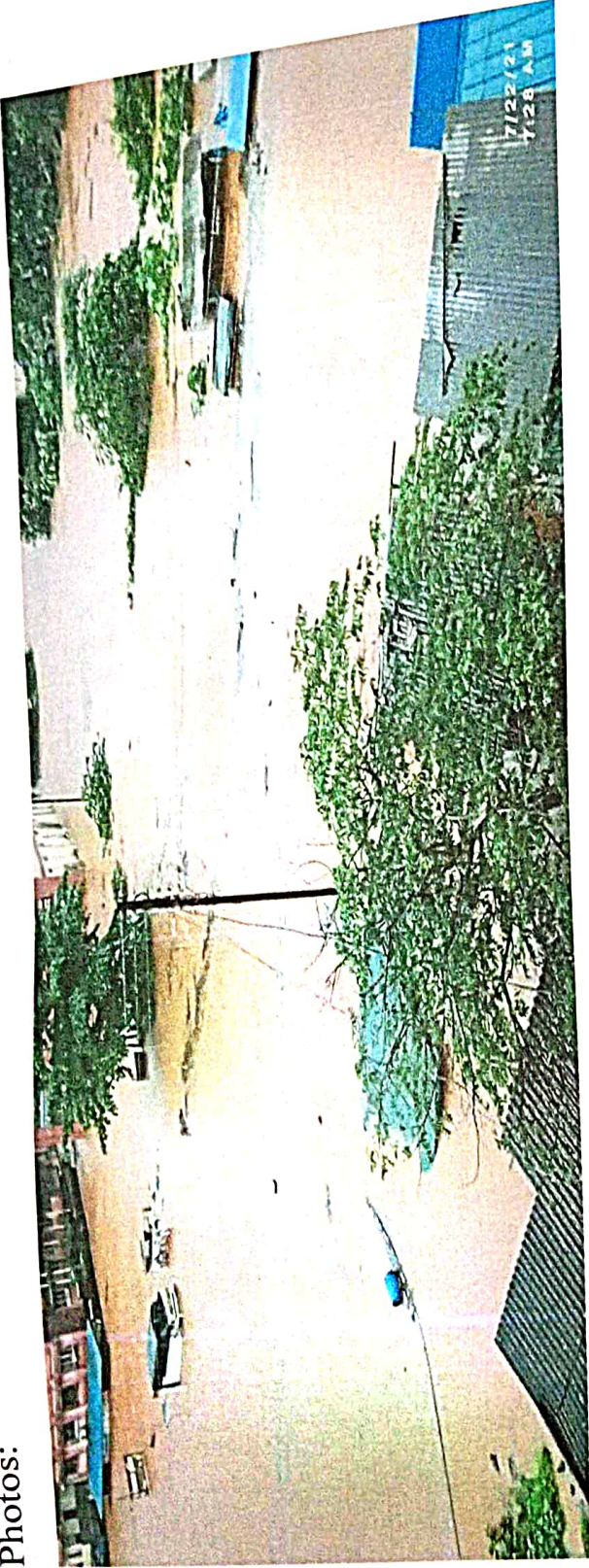
7. Community Engagement: It facilitated engagement with the Chiplun community, strengthening bonds and building goodwill between the college and the local residents.

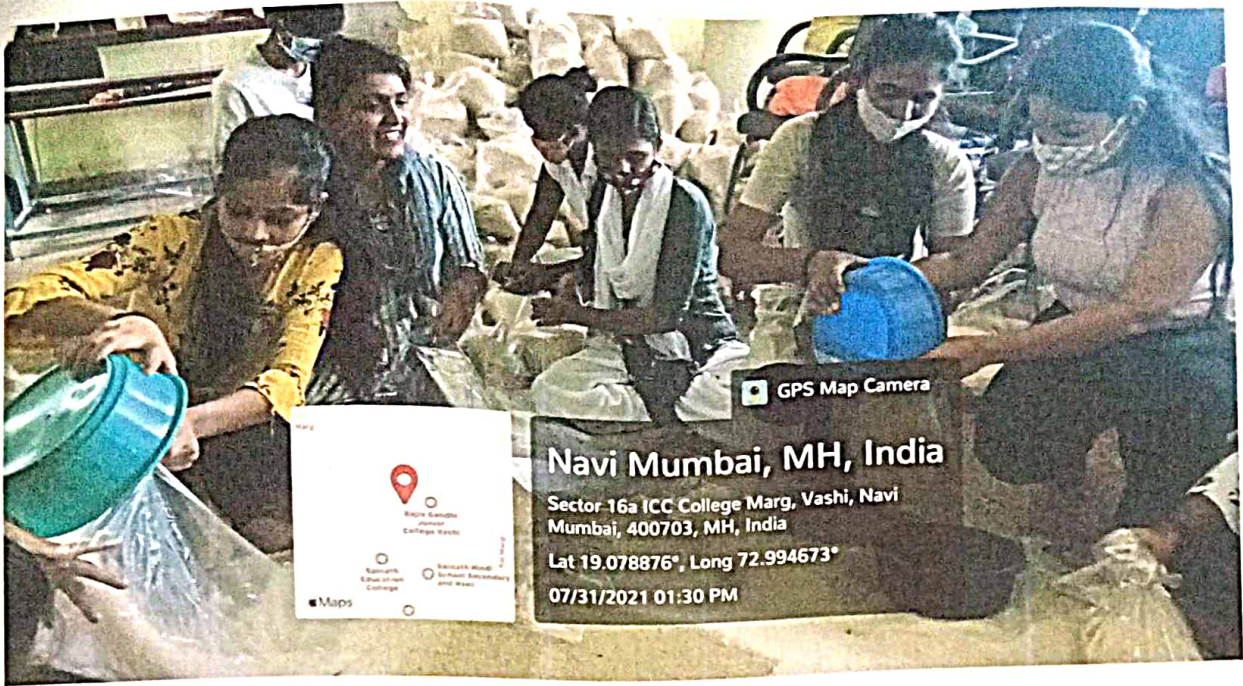
