

Descriptive Report :-

Introduction:

On December 1, 2021, Sainath Education Trust's Rajiv Gandhi College in collaboration with the National Service Scheme (NSS) organized a special event for the distribution of food to HIV-positive children. 2. Awareness: The awareness session helped educate attendees about HIV/AIDS, reducing stigma, and increasing understanding of the disease.

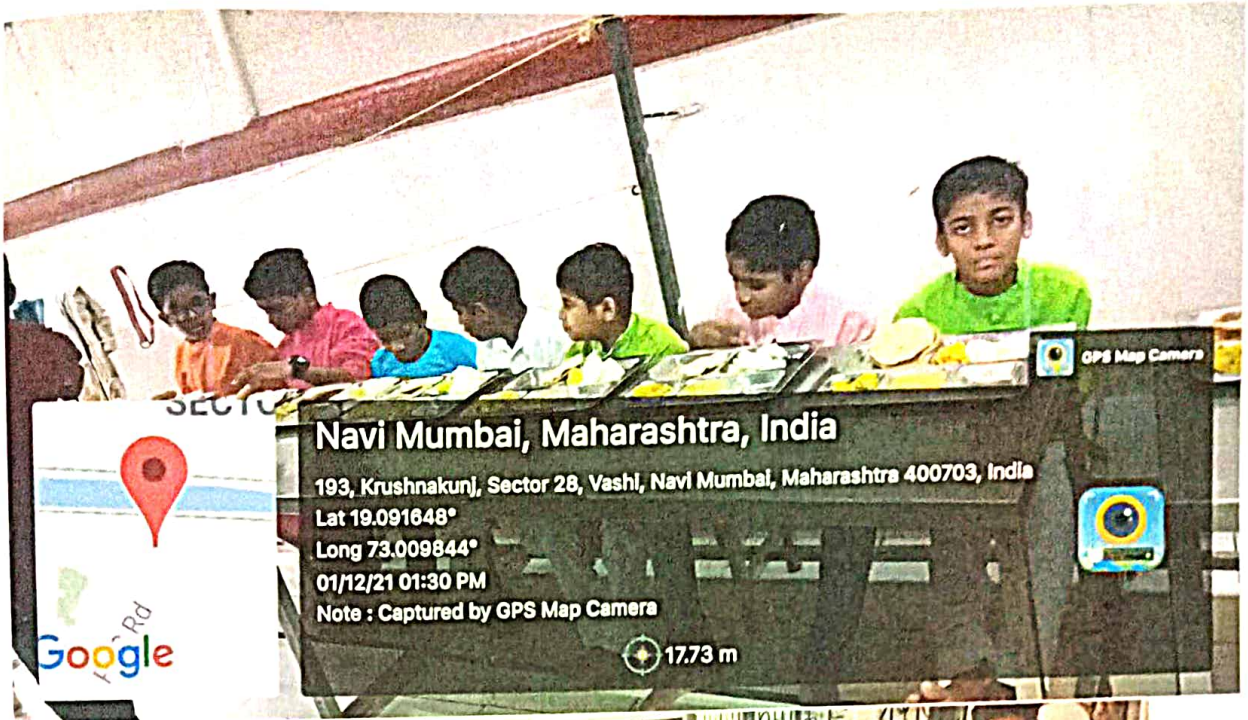
3. Community Engagement: The event fostered a sense of community and solidarity, showcasing support for vulnerable individuals.
