
59.1% students were satisfactorily while 30.7% thoroughly satisfied with the teachers' preparations for the classes while some were not satisfied with it.






96.1% students thought the teachers were able to communicate effectively with them. Very few students found lack of communication with the teachers.


43.8% of the students found the teacher's approach to teaching was excellent in all perspectives, 33.7% were found very good while 18.5% found it fair approach.






91 % students found a fair internal evaluation process by the teachers while others found it unfair.


85.4% students felt that their performance in assignment was discussed with them while 7.6% felt it was discussed sometimes and the remaining felt not discussed.






92.9% students felt the college takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for them.


94.7% students felt the teaching and mentoring process in college facilitated them in cognitive, social and emotional growth.






82.8% of students agreed the college provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow while 14% of students are neutral in opinion and the remainder disagreed.




94.4 % students considered that teachers inform them about their expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes while remaining did consider.






94.6% students thought their guardian teacher did a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to them.




94 % students felt the teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications and very few didn't think so.






 $94.6\ \%$ students felt the teachers identify their strengths and encourage them by providing the right level of challenges.




93.2% students felt the teachers were able to identify their weaknesses and helped them to overcome them.






96.9 % students thought the college makes an effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.




92.4% students considered the college/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.






87.1% of students felt the teachers encouraged them to participate in extracurricular activities while 10.3% of students were neutral.




94.3 % students felt efforts were made by the college/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make them ready for the world of work.






97.3 % of the students thought skill development course offered to them are very much useful to them but the remaining didn't so.




 $91.5\,\%$ professional course students felt internship opportunities provided by the college to get hands-on training.






90.3% students felt their bridge course experience which was conducted in their First year to overcome their academic gap was great.






81.4 % students felt the college placement cell provides them opportunities for their future while 12.6% opinionated neutral.




83.9% students felt the teachers teach using different teaching aids (Teaching methods) while 12.5% opinionated neutral.






88.4 % students felt the teachers organize virtual seminars/workshops/practical while 15.8% opinionated neutral.




82.7 % of students agreed teachers take remedial classes to overcome the gap between what they know and what they expected to know. While 12.6% of students' opinions were neutral.






 $80.1\,\%$ students agreed the teachers organize guest lecture series for subject expert guidance while 15.4 % were neutral.




84.2% of students agreed that the overall quality of teaching-learning process in their college is very good while 12.6% were neutral.








83.3% of the students agreed that they were guided to use the latest technology for the projects and assignments while 12.8% of the students were neutral on opinion.
