For Internal examinations and University external examination, College examination Committee is responsible for:

b. Block arrangements for internal and theory examinations will be prepared and displayed.

c. Question paper preparation, due to covid all exams of Second Half 2021 (Winter Section Exams) being held online so, question papers are prepared by subject teachers in testmoz software. Then according to a circular of University of Mumbai stated Semester II Regular exams being held offline with a pattern (50% MCQ's and 50% Theory). So accordingly teachers have prepared question papers.

d. Secure management of examination paper according to the time table each day paper is scheduled and links will be shared on time.

e. Provision of adequate examination supervision (invigilation).

f. Each student attendance has been traced by Google form attendance link by supervisor.

g. Procedure relating to recruitment, appointment and management of examination supervisors.

h. Implementing any examination adjustments for students as required.

i. All FY and SY Internal, Theory and Practical examination final marks are uploaded into the college Exam Software and results are displayed within 40 days on the college website.

j. All TY Internal, Theory and Practical examination final marks are uploaded on university portal within stipulated time.
