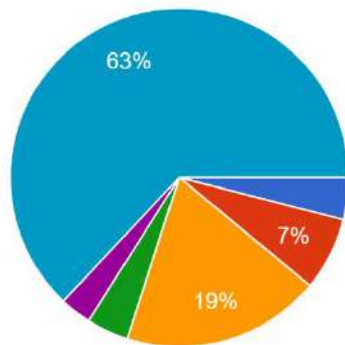

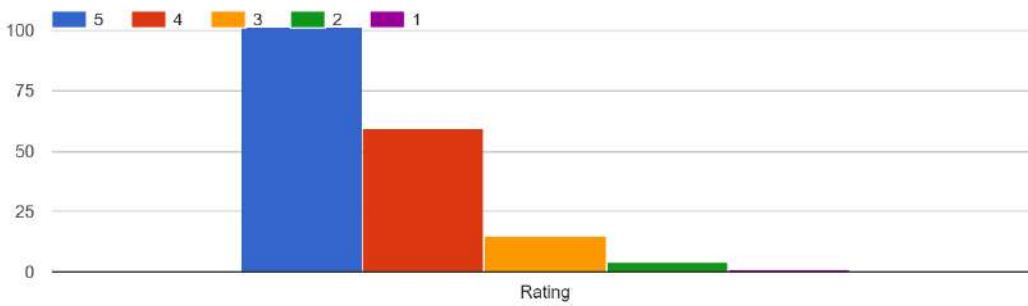

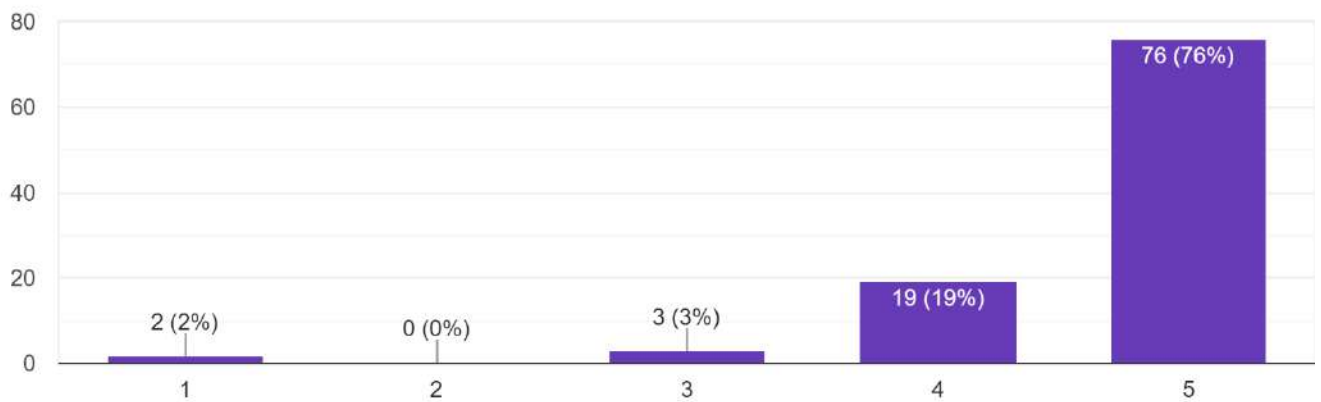

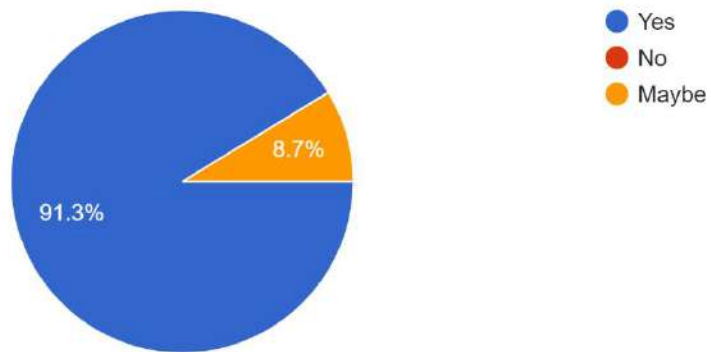

CIBIL Score

- CIBIL Score is a 3 digit numeric summary of credit history.
- The value of credit score ranges from 300 to 900.
- The closer your score is to 900, the higher are the chances of your loan getting approved.
- Score above 650 is generally acceptable to Banks/FIs.

To maintain a good credit score:

- Always pay your dues on time in full.
- Keep your balances low.
- Maintain a healthy mix of credit (secured/unsecured).
- Apply for new credit in moderation.
- Monitor your co-signed, guaranteed and joint accounts regularly.
- Review your credit report once in a year.

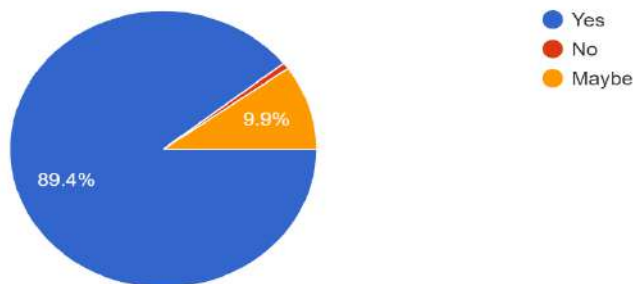

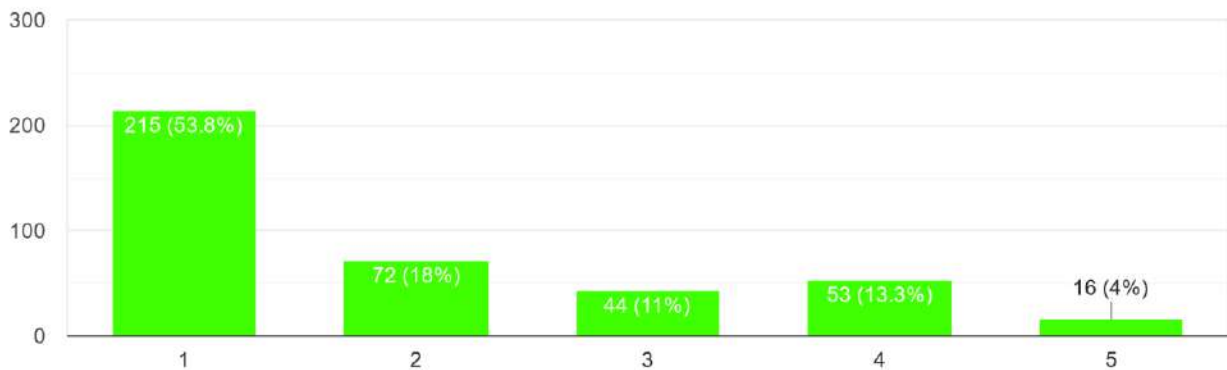

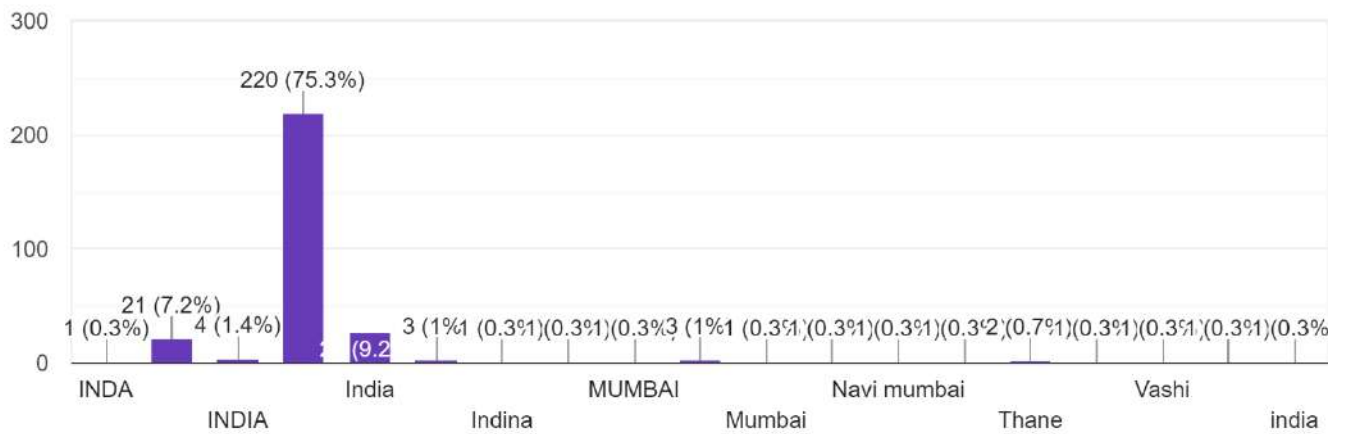

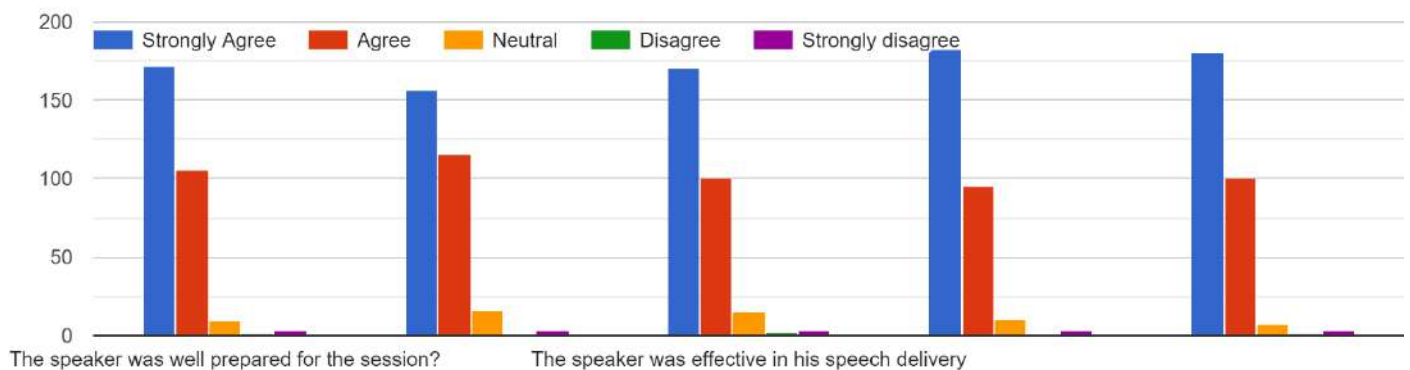

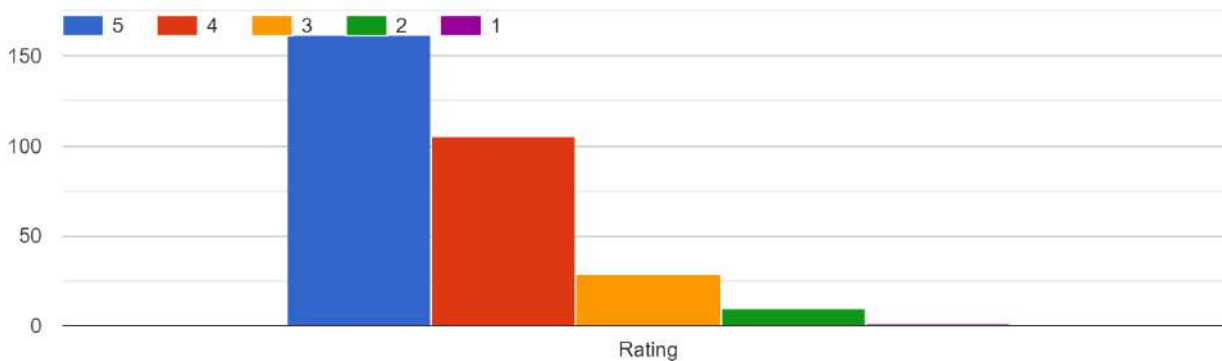

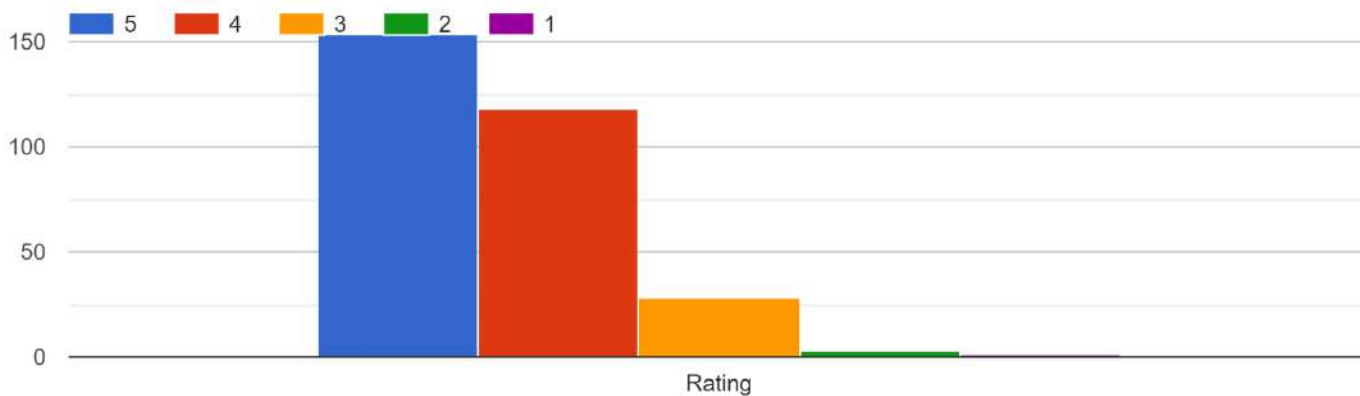
