





Introduction:

There has been an increasing interest in AI during pandemic in Education. AI is transforming how we live, work and play. By enabling new technologies like self-driving cars and recommendation system or improving old ones like medical diagnostic and search engines, the demand for expertise in AI learning is growing rapidly. 


