Details Of Activity:

1. The first term training was started with the welcoming of Field Coordinator Asst.Prof. Mahesh Dhaygude and Extension work teacher Mrs. Priyanka More and Ms. Sarita Shinde.
2. After the introduction, Asst.Prof. Mahesh Dhaygude started the session: sir explained the benefits of joining in DLLE and improvement in soft skills, as all projects are communication based.
3. Sir explained the important parts in DLLE such as EXTENSION WORK TEACHER STUDENT MANAGER EXTENSION MEMBERS.
4. The DLLE member students have to work for 120 hours in a year for claiming 10 grace marks.
5. He provided information related to various projects.
6. The project 'Survey of Women's status in Society' covers the survey to be conducted by students on women in the peripheral area of their residence. The students have to conduct an interview of 40 women. The sample questionnaire provided in resource material can be used for an interview. They can prepare their own questionnaire. After survey, Answers given by interviewees must be properly analyzed and recorded properly and compared with expected answers. After analysis the report must be prepared as per prescribed format.



7. To develop marketing and entrepreneurial skills among students, **Anna Poorna Yojna (APY)** is started as one of the projects of DLLE. In this project the students have to arrange minimum 25 sales of Food items or non food items. The sales made by students must be recorded as per prescribed format. The students can earn a reasonable amount of profit through these activities. Hygiene must be maintained while cooking and serving the food. At the end of the project, students have to prepare a report and submit it to the Student Manager who in turn will submit reports to Extension work teachers.
8. The extension teacher has to maintain Accounts file, circular file and report file and regularly submit the reports of the college to the DLLE.
9. Students must participate in the UDAAN festival of DLLE organized in the month of Jan./Feb. of every year. Poster competition and skit competitions are organized in UDAAN Festival.
10. Program ended with the vote of thanks given by Student manager Rajkumar Singh.

Outcome: -

- Students have got an idea of DLLE activities and projects and teamwork.
- It taught us that we can have educational programs for social change.
- It guided students how to carry out the DLLE program smoothly along with academic education.
- Got information about various projects along with the project taken by the college such as,
 1. APY (Anna Poorna Yojana)




Details of Activity:

Rajiv Gandhi College of Arts, Commerce and Science has organized 'Trees Plantation Drive' on 14th August 2022 as a part of 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav'. It was an initiative by NSS unit along with DLLE unit at Sector 28, Oriental international school Vashi, Near BLUE DIAMOND hotel. The 'Trees Plantation Drive' started with prayer at 8.45 AM and a Motivational speech by Asst. Prof. Anamika Singh in the morning.

The aim of this drive was to plant 750 trees and the speaker also spoke about the importance of tree plantation. Banyan (Bargat), Black Berries (Jamun), Mango, Neem, Jackfruit (Kathal), Badam (Almond), Peepal are saplings that are planted in the drive. The saplings are placed on the hole and ready to be planted. The students and teachers participated in the drive enthusiastically and helped each other in planting the saplings. Students were divided into groups and teachers were appointed as an incharge along with each group. Each group was allotted with different areas. We carefully removed the cover of the saplings, held the soil that protects the roots, and placed them on to the holes. We poured the hole with soil, making sure the saplings are properly planted and placed a bamboo stick beside the plants.

After our goal of planting 750 trees was achieved. Refreshments were distributed to all the students and teachers. Finally, the event ended and we came home with enthusiasm and happiness after doing such great work.

Outcome: -

1. All of the students enjoyed the tree planting activity and agreed that it is beneficial for environmental purposes and also for them.
2. Students got proper knowledge of spreading awareness regarding tree plantation and its importance.
3. Students also realized the true value of balance among people, life, and nature.
4. Tree planting is one way of showing our efforts in making this world a much better place to live in. Without the trees, nothing will keep us safe from the typhoons, we could not eat nutritious fruits and vegetables, and definitely we could not breathe fresh air. Build today, plant for tomorrow. 

Those who scored above 60% got the online participation certificate on the mail which they have provided while filing the details in google form and with this successfully the quiz was completed.

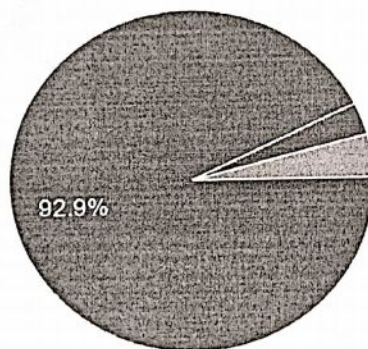
Outcomes: -

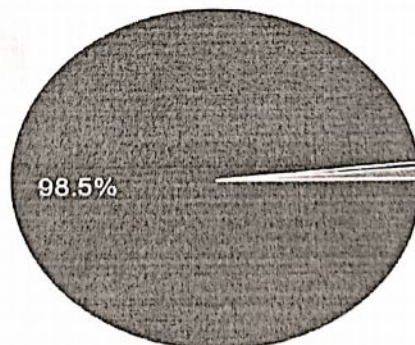

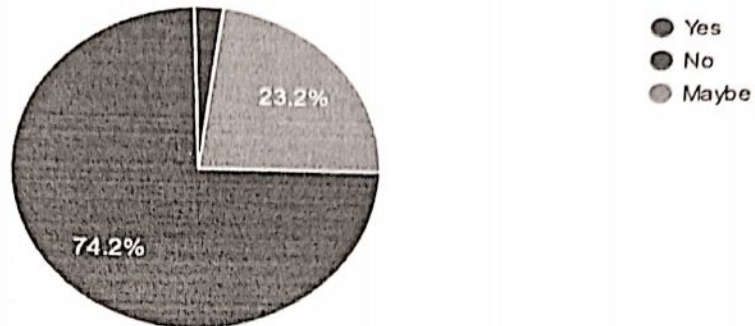

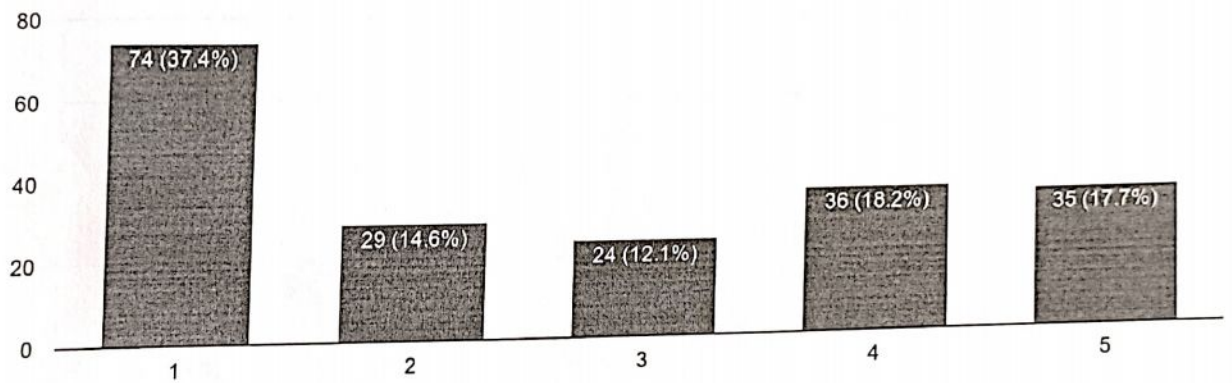

The participation in following competitions is optional with prior registration before specified due date. On the spot entry will not be accepted under any circumstances.

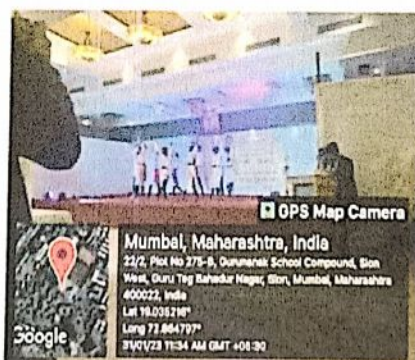
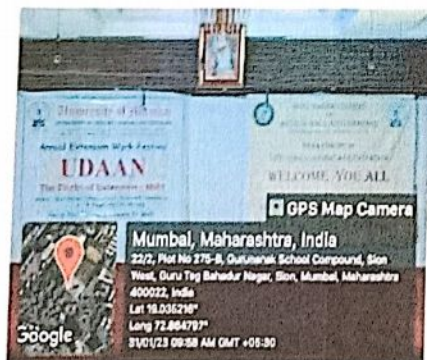
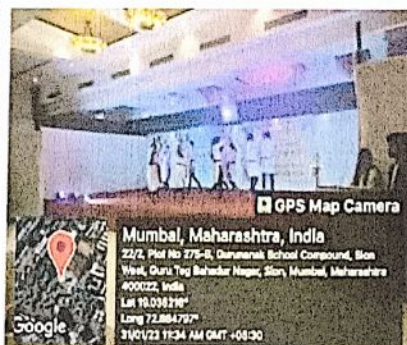
The winners will be honoured with the DLLE Certificate during the Valedictory Function of the Festival.
