Report on Plastic Waste Collection Drive

Introduction:

On the 15th of December 2022, the NSS (National Service Scheme) unit of Sainath Education Trust's Rajiv Gandhi College of Arts, Commerce, and Science organized a plastic waste collection drive in the Juhu Village Area.
