Details of the Activity:-

The College has organized Prabhat Pheri to sensitise about the 75th Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav under the theme 'Har Ghar Tiranga' Campaign. The day was started with great enthusiasm and patriotic fervour in our college premises with staff, students and parents to mark 75 years of freedom. On this Special occasion the program started with **flag hosting** by the Head of the Institute Mr. Harbansh Singh, The Trustee Member Mr. Aasharam Yadav, Administrative officer Mr. T.P Singh and The Principal of Rajiv Gandhi College of Arts, Commerce and Science Mr.

B.S Pandey followed by the National Anthem.

We as Indian Pay respect to all the leaders who fought bravely for our nation's freedom in the past, on this day The President of Sainath Education Trust Mr. Harbansh Singh flagged off the Prabhat Pheri Rajiv Gandhi College of Arts, Commerce and Science Gate, sector 10 Vashi.
