Introduction:

Details of Activity:

Rajiv Gandhi College of Arts, Commerce and Science has organized 'Trees Plantation Drive' 18th June-2022. The 'Trees Plantation Drive' started at 8.30 AM with a Motivational speech by Asst. Prof. Rafat Shaikh in the morning.

The aim of this drive was to plant 25 trees and the speaker also spoke about the importance of tree plantation. Banyan (Bargat), Black Berries (Jamun), Mango, Neem, Jackfruit (Kathal), Badam (Almond), Peepal are saplings that are planted in the drive. The saplings are placed on the hole and ready to be planted. The students and teachers participated in the drive enthusiastically and helped each other in planting the saplings. Students were divided into groups and teachers were appointed as an incharge along with each group. Each group was allotted with different areas. We carefully removed the cover of the saplings, held the soil that protects the roots, and placed them on to the holes. We poured the hole with soil, making sure the saplings are properly planted and placed a bamboo stick beside the plants.

After our goal of planting 750 trees was achieved. Refreshments were distributed to all the students and teachers. Finally, the event ended and we came home with enthusiasm and happiness after doing such great work.

Outcome: -

- 1. All of the students enjoyed the tree planting activity and agreed that it is beneficial for environmental purposes and also for them.
- 2. Students got proper knowledge of spreading awareness regarding tree plantation and its importance.
- 3. Students also realized the true value of balance among people, life, and nature.
- 4. Tree planting is one way of showing our efforts in making this world a much better place to live in. Without the trees, nothing will keep us safe from the typhoons, we could not eat nutritious fruits and vegetables, and definitely we could not breathe fresh air. Build today, plant for tomorrow.
