Details of the Activity :-

The event "A Motivational Talk on 'Gavacha Itihas' - An initiative to create awareness about the history of Navi Mumbai to celebrate 75th Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav under the theme 'Har Ghar Tiranga' was successfully conducted by NSS and IQAC team of Rajiv Gandhi College of Arts, Commerce and Science, Vashi, Navi Mumbai. This event was presided by Ex-Member of Parliament, President: Sainath Education Trust Hon'ble Shri. Haribansh Singhji and started with welcoming our eminent guest of honor Shri. Dashrath Bhagat, Senior BJP leader, President of Navi Mumbai "Punarvasan Samajik Sanstha" and member of Rayat Shikshan Sanstha. Chief guests Prof. (CA) Eknath Patil, one of the Senior most practicing chartered accountants in Vashi and Adv. P.C. Patil, Chairman of Dyan Vikas Sanstha, Koperkhairane, Navi Mumbai. Sainath Education Trust Administrative officer Shri T. P. Singh sir also blessed his presence to us.

- This event helped students to build a good citizenship spirit within them.




