








According to this survey 90.1% students considered that more than 75% of the syllabus was taught by the teachers and very few students i.e. 9.8% considered it below.




91.6% students were thoroughly satisfied with the teachers' preparations for the classes while very few were not satisfied with it.





95.9% students thought the teachers were able to communicate effectively with them. Very few students found lack of communication with the teachers.




96.1% of the students found the teacher's approach to teaching was excellently good. While very few did not.








96.6% students found a fair internal evaluation process by the teachers while others found it unfair.




88.7% students felt that their performance in assignment was discussed with them while 6.7% felt it was discussed sometimes and the remaining felt not discussed.






93.4% students felt the college takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for them.




96.7% students felt the teaching and mentoring process in college facilitated them in cognitive, social and emotional growth.






87.7% of students agreed the college provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow while 9.5% of students are neutral in opinion and the remainder disagreed.




96.2% students considered that teachers inform them about their expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes while remaining did consider.






96.5% students thought their guardian teacher did a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to them.




96.7% students felt the teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications and very few didn't think so.





94.7 % students felt the teachers identify their strengths and encourage them by providing the right level of challenges.




93.5% students felt the teachers were able to identify their weaknesses and helped them to overcome them.






96.5 % students thought the college makes an effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.




93.9% students considered the college/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.




89.1% of students felt the teachers encouraged them to participate in extracurricular activities while 8.5% of students were neutral.

94% of the students thought skill development course offered to them are very much useful to them but the remaining didn't so.




90.7% professional course students felt internship opportunities provided by the college to get hands-on training.



93.4% students felt their bridge course experience which was conducted in their First year to overcome their academic gap was great.










80% students felt the college placement cell provides them opportunities for their future while 14.5% opinionated neutral.




85.5% students felt the teachers teach using different teaching aids (Teaching methods) while 12.3% opinionated neutral.






82.4 % students felt the teachers organize virtual seminars/workshops/practical for competitive exams while 13.6% opinionated neutral.




82.3 % of students agreed teachers take remedial classes to overcome the gap between what they know and what they expected to know. While 13.8% of students' opinions were neutral.

83.2 % students agreed the teachers organize guest lecture series for subject expert guidance while 13.9 % were neutral.




84.7% of students agreed that the overall quality of teaching-learning process in their college is very good while 11.6% were neutral.








88.8% students agreed their college fest Prarrambh - Navi Mumbai inculcates human values through its socio-cultural aspect while 9% were neutral in opinion.
