



WEBINAR ON 'WORLD ZOONOSIS DAY (06.07.2021)

DATE: 06.07.2021

A Webinar was held on 06.07.2021 to commemorate 'World Zoonosis Day' which is celebrated to mark the successful administration of first ever vaccine against rabies, a zoonotic disease, by French Biologist Louis Pasteur.

Zoonoses are diseases which can be transmitted from animals to man and vice-versa. It can be bacteria, virus, fungi, ticks, mosquitoes and parasites. Zoonotic disease passed from animal or insect to human being can range from minor short term illness to a major life illness, sometimes even fatal.

About 61% to 73% or nearly 1415 pathogens cause infections to man. For example, animal flu, bird flu, anthrax, sleeping sickness, ebola, dengue, malaria, swine flu and the recent pandemic COVID-19 etc. Transmission can be by air, insect bite, contaminated meat, improperly cooked meat, hiring bike/boat, close contact infected person or animal, contact with livestock. The beautiful pet bird parrot also can infect man by causing 'parrot fever' or 'Psitta corsis', the symptoms of which are similar to COVID-19.

Resource person for the Webinar was Dr. Geetanjali Sarangi, Professor & Head, Department of Microbiology, Fakir Mohan Medical College & Hospital, Balasore, Odisha. She had a brilliant academic career from secondary education to MBBS and MD in Microbiology. She has contributed many articles for several National and International Journals of remote She has given lectures at various symposia, seminars, workshops interest now is: pandemic COVID-19, its molecular diagnos genome sequencing, identifying variants of SARS-Cov2.

She explained:


- Importance of zoonotic diseases;
- · Classification of zoonosis;
- Mode of transmission, life cycle, ecological agents;
- About populations which are at high risk like pregnant women, people undergoing chemotherapy, organ transplantation;
- Most susceptible groups are: farmers, livestock owners, pet lovers who share air and space with animals and birds;
- Factors responsible for emergence of zoonosis;
- About various diseases like Avian flu (H5N1), swine flu (H1N1), MERS, ebola, Hanta Virus Pulmonary Syndrome, COVID-19; causes, symptoms, prophylaxis, control measures.

Conclusion: In future, public health workers, veterinarians should keep a vigilant eye for the possible emergence of new zoonotic diseases.









Visit to IWSA, Vashi (10 & 11.02.2023)

Students of SY BSc participated in a Workshop on 'Smart Waste Management Technology' organized by IWSA, Vashi on 10th & 11th February, 2023 and presented posters on e-waste management.

In today's world, evolving technologies and lifestyles are creating different types of waste: bio waste, medical waste, e-waste, industrial waste, solid waste etc. These accumulating wastes are creating the problem of their safe disposal. For example, e-waste gets generated when we dispose old electrical and electronic devices such as: mobiles, head phones, computers, laptops, monitors, power banks, chargers, hair dryers, batteries, mixers, ovens, television sets, music systems etc.

Electrical and electronic appliances are composed of different toxic and non-toxic materials. Materials such as iron, aluminum, glass, plastic account for 80% of e-waste. E-waste also contains hazardous substances such as: lead, mercury, cadmium, lithium, zinc, copper, strontium, poly chlorinated bi-phenyl (PCB), poly brominated bi-phenyl (PBB), poly brominated bi-phenyl ethers (PBBE), brominated flame retardants (BFR) etc. Metals such as iron, aluminum, copper, silver, lead can be recycled; other components of e-waste require special treatment and proper disposal.

India generates about 4.1 million tonnes of e-waste per annum and growing at 10% to reach 8 million tonnes by 2025. It constitutes 3-8% of solid waste. Developing countries are facing imminent danger from the e-waste generated by developed countries, which marvel at their technological revolutions. Most of the times, this e-waste get dumped in the developing countries, where cost of recycling the waste is much lower. Advantages of recycling of e-waste: recovery and reuse of precious metals, saving landfill space, preserving natural resources, reducing air, water and land pollution, supporting community development by protecting health and environment. Sustainable waste management increases affordability, provides employment. Government should organize and manage waste collection and recycling facilities. Citizens are also responsible for waste treatment and cleaning operations.


