- 8. It has Built Positive relationships between new students and faculty of RGC.



Ms. Vinita Rajani took Workshop on the theme "Woman health and fitness" on the occasion of international women's day.



### Outcomes: -

- Students understood Nuclear chemistry greatly assists the understanding of medical treatments (such as cancer radiotherapy) and has enabled these treatments to improve. It includes the study of the production and use of radioactive sources for a range of processes.
- They have got an idea that Nuclear chemistry is the sub-field of chemistry dealing with radioactivity, nuclear processes and transformations in the nuclei of atoms, such as nuclear transmutation and nuclear properties.
- 3. A typical nuclear reaction involves two reacting particles such as a heavy target nucleus and a light bombarding particle and produces two new particles as a heavier product nucleus and a lighter ejected particle this basic concept is visualized through PPT by Speaker.
- 4. Medicinal Uses of Radioisotopes and Applications in Pharma Industry.
- 5. It developed a good interest in the topic of radioisotopes and nuclear chemistry.
- 6. Nuclear energy protects air quality and it generates power through fission, which is the process of splitting uranium atoms to produce energy. The heat released by fission is used to create steam that spins a turbine to generate electricity without the harmful byproducts emitted by fossil fuels.
- 7. All the students first got hands-on training at GM Counter and NA- I Detector.
- Students got hands-on information about alpha radiation and it was very effective and exciting for all the participants.






