Participants got lots of detailed knowledge of yoga.

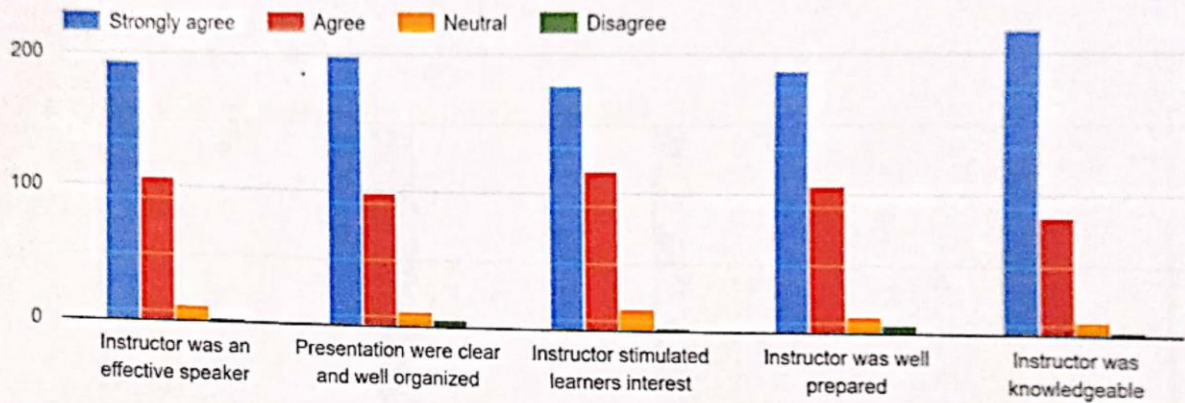

4. Basically to value them and to respect them like everybody else and give a new perspective towards girl child and to decrease discrimination.

Participants got lots of detailed knowledge of yoga.

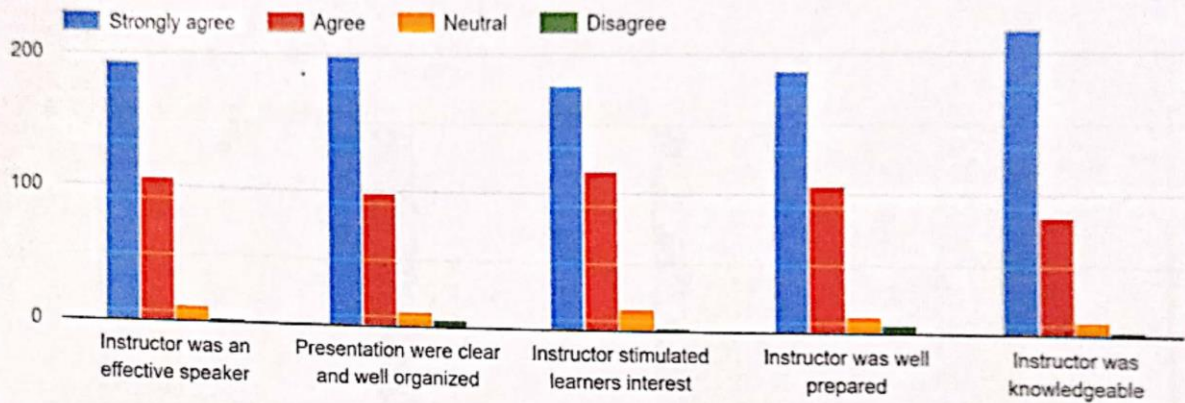
